Most recently, he and colleagues published an update to the traditional legal test for testamentary capacity (Banks v Goodfellow) in the Canadian Bar Review.

Maureen spent 7 years as the National Medical/ Health Reporter for the CBC and is a 3-time winner of CMA/CNA award for excellence in health reporting. Maureen has publicly advocated for the right of Canadians to choose an assisted death, serving as the co-chair of the Provincial/ Territorial Expert Advisory Group on Physician Assisted Death.
